#### Content of specific substances" - e.g. energy, macronutrients (protein, fat &

carbohydrates), micronutrients (protein, fat & minerals) and other nutrients

## FAO's mandate

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
- Achieving food security for all is at the heart of FAO's efforts - to make sure people have regular access to enough high-quality food to lead active, healthy lives.
- FAO's mandate is to "raise levels of nutrition", improve agricultural productivity, better the lives of rural populations and contribute to the growth of the world economy.


### Food Composition Data (FCD)-the why?

- FCD is fundamental to:
  - Assess dietary adequacy & evaluate nutrient intakes (under-& over nutrition and deficiencies)
  - > Assess intakes & diet-related disease relationships
  - Develop food-based dietary guidelines (FBDGs)
  - > Calculate nutrients in national food balance sheet (FBS)
  - Formulate institutional & therapeutic diets
  - > Diets for special purposes space, defence, etc
  - Identify & promote nutritionally important foods
  - > Nutrition labelling & claims of products-consumer information

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- Nutrition education & training
- Biodiversity & agricultural research
- Formulate appropriate policy & strategy

## FAO & food composition



### Some issues...

- Lack of awareness & priority by governments
- · Limited budget for FC activities
- Lack of / weak IT systems for data management
- Lack of resources laboratories, skilled personnel (data collection/interpretation), equipment & chemicals to generate FCD
- Problems related to sampling, methodology & data quality
- · Lack of proper understanding on the use of FCT
- Consumer understanding

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## FAO's role in ASEANFOODS

- Provide technical & financial assistance in:
  - Capacity building for generation & compilation of FCD
    training courses etc
  - > Upgrading laboratory facilities
  - Organizing meetings, technical consultations, technical workshops etc
  - Assessing the needs & gaps in the generation, compilation & usage of FCD
  - Guideline on FC activities sampling, QA, compilation, methodology, tools etc
  - > Generation of IEC material

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# FAO's role in ASEANFOODS

- Facilitate user-friendly materials / publications to promote usage of FCD at various levels - brochures, booklet etc
- Promote data information exchange & expertise sharing
- Advocate & raise awareness on FC activities among various stakeholders
- · Monitor the progress of FC activities
- Improve the quantity of FCD of local & indigenous foods to ensure indigenous people's food systems, biodiversity and sustainable diets

# FAO's food composition activities in Asia

- Promote regional FC activities through regional data centers
  - ASEANFOODS Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam
  - SAARCFOODS Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka
  - NEASIADOODS China, Japan, Korea, Mongolia, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Macao

# FAO's food composition activities in Asia, cont...

- Provide support in organizing meetings
  - > SAARCFOODS
  - > ASEANFOODS
  - > NEASIADOODS
  - Regional expert consultation of the Asia-Pacific Network for Food and Nutrition on Food Composition Activities, Thailand, 2003
  - > Asian course on food composition, India, 2006
- Provide support in the development/ strengthening of ASEAN FCT

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# FAO's food composition activities in Asia, cont...

- Provide technical assistance in implementing projects
  - Managing biodiversity for sustainable food security & nutrition in Afghanistan (GCP/AFG/047/GER) – managing local species with high nutritional value through development of computerized database on composition, maintaining communities knowledge & use of local species
  - Sustainable insect farming & harvesting for better nutrition, improve food security and household generation (TCP/LAO/3301) – compiling data qualities of various insect species etc

## Suggested future activities....

#### **ASEAN level**

- Assessment of facilities available within countries (incl labs)
- Data-base management systems
- Regional trainings
- PT at regional level
- Include additional nutrients eg trans fats, GI, etc
- Linkages b/w govt, private food industry & labs
- Identify correct departments in countries/ experts
