Objectives:

- Development of criteria for quality evaluation of published FCTs/FCDB

 - Evaluation of country-specific FCTs using the developed draft criteria for quality evaluation from Activity I
 - Discussion on over-all quality, discrepancies of food groups, completeness of nutrients, FCTs format, food description, language, etc. and possibility for harmonization
- III. Identifying current problems and needs, gaps in each country's FCD, etc.
- IV. Planning of next steps
 - Discussion on practical process to develop good quality FCTs
 - Suggesting subsequent activities e.g. workshops and timelines
 - Strengthening public-private partnership
 - Possibility for developing ASEAN FCT/FCDB

Expected Outcomes:

- 1. Draft criteria, sub-criteria, weighting and scoring system for quality evaluation of published FCTs/FCDB (which will be proposed to INFOODS for consideration in preparation of the INFOODS guideline)
- 2. Status and quality of current FCTs in ASEAN countries
- Agreement on future actions that should be taken to improve country FCTs and possibility for developing ASEAN FCT/FCDB
